

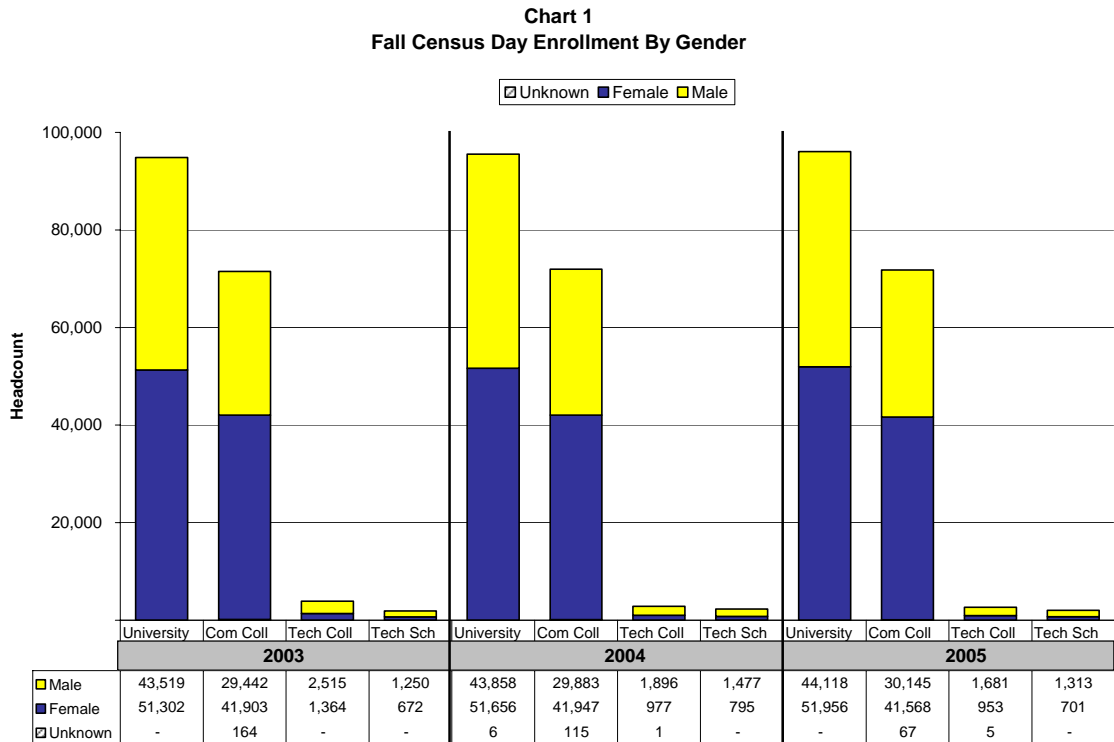
Kansas Postsecondary Database Update

April 19, 2006

The Kansas Postsecondary Database (KSPSD) started live data collection in the fall of 2003. During the first year of data collection only basic census day enrollment information was collected. Today the database has grown to include data on student outcomes (e.g. success in courses and awards earned), career and technical education, adult basic education, program inventory, and program review. The database is also supplemented with data from outside sources like the student’s Pell grant application and registration for the ACT test.

I. Census Enrollments

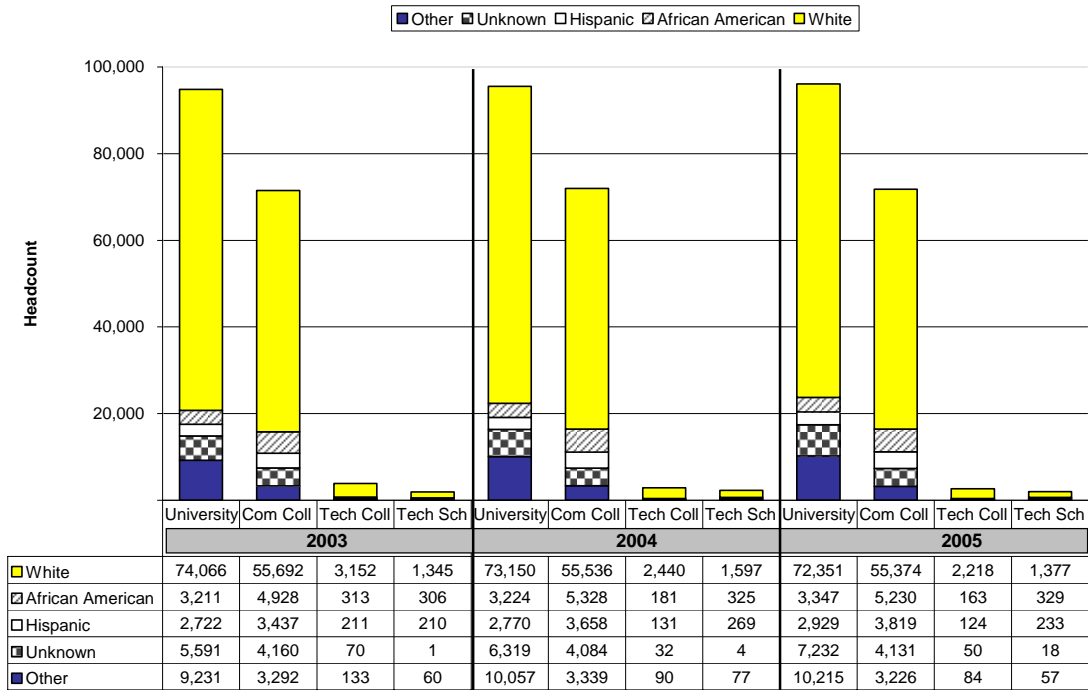
Census Enrollment is the first type of data collection in KSPSD. The collection contains enrollment information as of the 20th class day. Appendix A shows individual institution enrollment for the fall 2005 census day by gender, race, and residency. Since three years of data are available on this information, trend analysis is possible.



A three-year trend analysis of the gender enrollment pattern in Kansas public higher education institutions, found in chart 1, shows no change. Universities and Community Colleges typically have about 45% males and 55% females while the Technical Institutions have about 65% males and 35% females.

Chart 2 shows the census day enrollment patterns of Kansas public higher education institutions for fall 2003, fall 2004, and fall 2005. University census enrollment consistently is about 75% white, while African American and Hispanic

students only make up about 7%. Community College census day enrollment hover around 75% white but they have approximately 13% African American and Hispanic students. The Technical Colleges have a minority student enrollment of about 13%, while Technical Schools are comprised of about 16% African American and 11% Hispanic.

Fall Census Day Enrollment by Residency

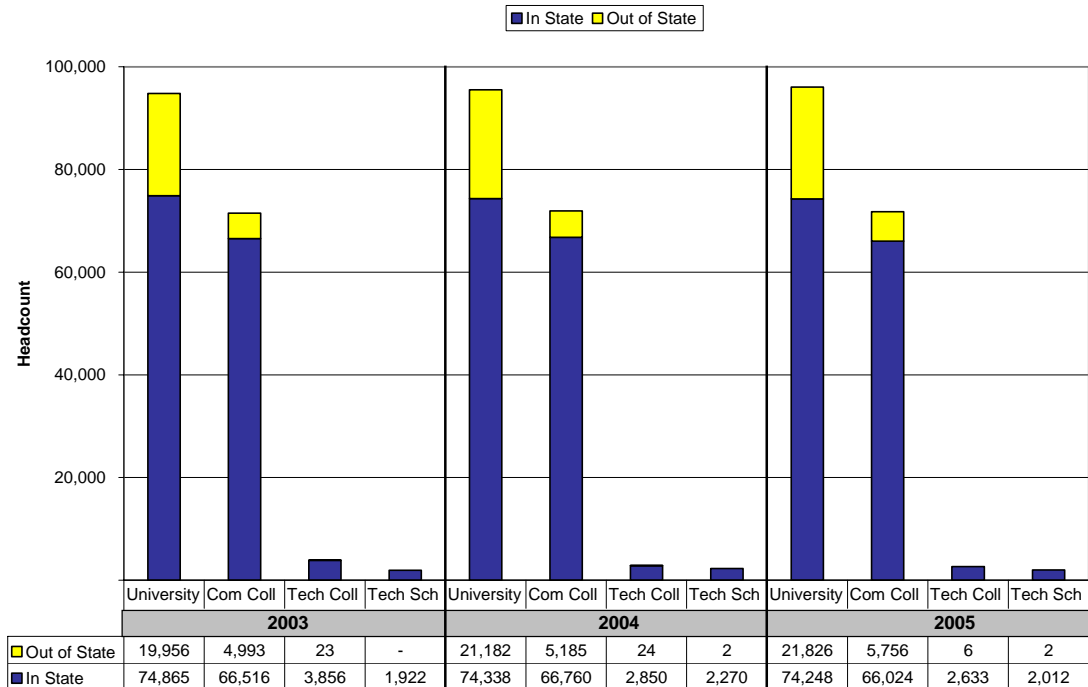
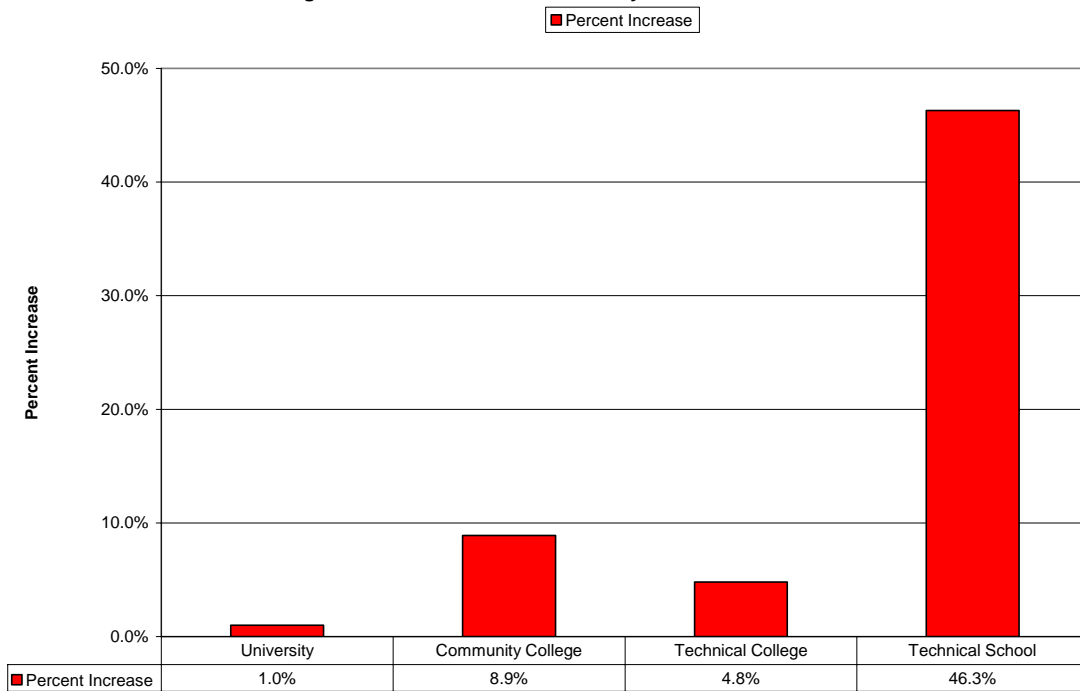


Chart 3 shows the residency patterns of our institutions, which have not changed dramatically over the three year period.

Census enrollments only collect information as of the 20th day. This snapshot excludes a significant number of students from the enrollment figures. Community Colleges and Technical Schools are most heavily impacted, as illustrated in chart 4, below. To gather a more accurate/inclusive representation of students served throughout the year, KSPSD also collects an academic year enrollment file. All students who officially attempt courses during a semester are included in this submission. Appendix B shows the institutional impact of a single point in time snapshot of enrollment. The Community College sector is one of the most heavily impacted by using a 20th day enrollment snapshot. In particular, Barton County Community College has an enrollment increase of 56.8% when an entire semester is considered instead of just the 20th day. This is due to the large amount of offerings they have at Fort Riley. The census day count impact is also heavy for Kansas City Kansas Technical School because they have an open enrollment policy. This type of policy allows students to start courses at any point of the year and not just a specific day in August.

II. Academic Year Enrollments

2004-2005 is the first year for the academic year enrollment collection. These data contain enrollment, course success, and graduation information for the previous summer, fall, and spring terms. Appendix C contains a yearly unduplicated headcount report by gender and also a summary of the awards granted during the 2005 academic year.

2005 Undergraduate Awards by Primary Ethnicity

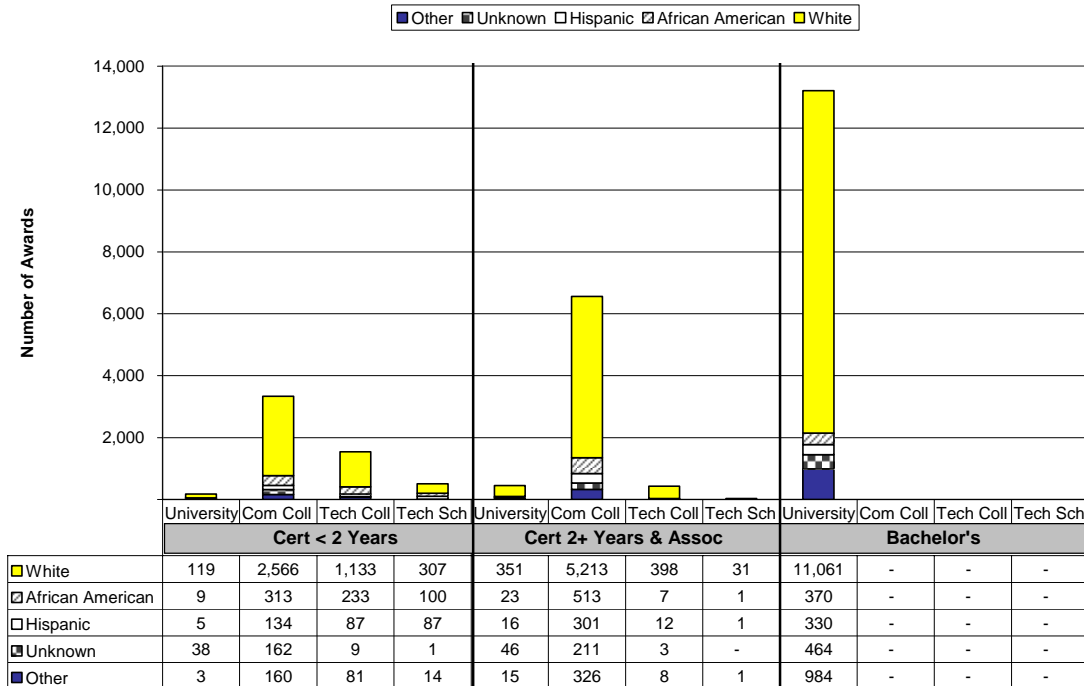


Chart 5 represents the ethnicity breakdowns of the class of 2005. When all undergraduate awards are considered, 83.4% of the universities' graduating class is white. Only 5.4% of the class is African American or Hispanic. Although the census enrollment cannot be compared exactly to this completion data, it can be observed that the distribution percent between the enrollment and completion data is about the same for each of the sectors.

III. Developmental Education Study

The need for developmental or remedial education is the focus of an on-going debate in higher education. With the help of the KSPSD academic year collection, for the first time Kansas can take a system wide look at developmental education. However, it must be stressed that only one year's worth of data is available at this time.

In order to fully understand the results of the developmental analysis, it is important to understand what type of developmental education takes place around the state. For purposes of this study, developmental education includes any course in mathematics, reading, or English designed to bring a students knowledge up to college level. None of the Technical Institutions offer developmental education. It is believed that all 19 of the Community Colleges offer developmental education in mathematics, English, and reading. All of the universities offer developmental math courses but only about half of the institutions offer developmental English or reading courses.

As part of the academic year collection, each institution identifies whether a student took developmental education during that year. They also identify whether the student passed the course with a grade of C or better. Appendix D shows institutional specific reports on this data. Two types of analysis are performed. For the first analysis, all developmental courses were considered regardless of the level or type of student. For the second

analysis, only cohort students were examined. Cohort is defined as a first-time, full-time, degree-seeking students.

During the 2004-2005 academic year University and Community College students made 21,874 attempts at any type of developmental courses. This does not necessarily represent single student attempts at developmental courses because a student could take the course multiple times during the year. In fact, for developmental mathematics in the year 2004-2005, between 15% and 16% of the attempts were repeat attempts. This was the highest subject repeat rate. For English, 7.9% of University attempts during 2004-2005 were repeat attempts while the Community Colleges had a yearly repeat rate of 10.1%.

Given the number of repeat courses, the next analysis performed was to determine a success rate. A single year analysis of the KSPSD data shows for all subject areas only 3 out of 5 attempts were successful. As mentioned above, for the KSPSD collection, a student is considered a success if they obtain a grade of C or more. Analysis of the individual subject areas show math has the lowest success rate at 59%. Both English and reading have a success rate of 66%.

It is a common belief that entering students are typically the ones taking developmental courses. However, in 2004-2005 only 32% of the developmental hours were taken by cohort students. Or in other words, only 32% of the developmental hours were taken by first-time, full-time, degree-seeking students. This means the about 60% of the developmental hours were taken by students who were part-time when they first entered, non-degree seeking, or not first-time students.

The final analysis was performed on cohort students only. The study examined the impact that enrolling in developmental courses has on retention rates. For this study, students enrolled in two or more institutions at one time could be counted in the report twice, both in the retained and transferred column. The table below shows the overall 1-year retention and transfer rates for the entire cohort, before considering developmental course enrollment.

In Fall 2004, 17.0% of the University cohort took developmental classes while 41.2% of the Community College cohort took developmental classes. The table below shows the retention and transfer rates based on enrollment of developmental courses.

The data clearly suggests that many students who, in their first year, do not succeed in developmental courses typically do not stay in college.
